Application of James Bowman No. 10027

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Third degree burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18 day of September  
A. D. 1933, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber  
and State of Utah, in Second District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Six months to three years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable District Atty. Johnson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is James Bowman

I was convicted under the name of James Bowman

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except Betty Theft, On  
account of being in possession of a stolen automobile, which  
delivered to the police, and a loading platform, which  
is now in the hands of the police.  
Also once for vagrancy, sixty days.
