Application of Leland H. Moore, No. 4899.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence.  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the second day of September  
A. D. 1927, at Brigham City County of Boxelder  
and State of Utah, in the first Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of one to twenty  
years,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Le Roy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Leland H. Moore.

I was convicted under the name of Leland Moore.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: None.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None.
