Application of Leland Moore No.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Penitentiary  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Assault with intent to commit rape.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of March, 1928.  
A. D., at Brigham City, County of Boxelder  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge W. C. Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Leroy B. Young prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Leland Moore  
I was convicted under the name of Leland Moore

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows:

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except before I was  
persuaded to plead guilty to the charge for which I am serving.

I am 18 years of age, now but was 17 years of age when sentenced.  
Permission to file this application was granted by your  
Honorable Body at a prior meeting of the Board.
