Application of Elmer Clifford West. # 1007

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Highway Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of July A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Elmer Clifford West I was convicted under the name of Ditto.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Thomas Jefferson Clark.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Burglary First degree
