Application of Elmer C. West, No. 4735

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of robbery.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of August A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in 2nd district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to five years to life with a recommendation that I serve five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Elmer C. West. I was convicted under the name of Elmer C. West.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Thomas Jefferson Clark.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except what shows on record.
