Application of Elmer C West No. 4735

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 31st day of July A. D. 1926, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake, and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L B Wright presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 5 to life

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E J Rogers prosecuted the case.
