Application of John van Schaik

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination or deportation
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of March
A. D. 1927, at Ogden County of Weber
and State of Utah, in First District Court Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to one year to twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph F. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Johannes Jacobus van Schaik
I was convicted under the name of John van Schaik

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except forgery
