Application of Pat Wilson #4870

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of May,
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, Utah County of Salt Lake
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from 6 months to
3 years,
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Paris Wilson
I was convicted under the name of Pat Wilson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: DeVern Lewis.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
