and State of Utah, in 5<sup>th</sup> Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge A. Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Ten Years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Samuel Cline prosecuted the case.
