Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of January A. D. 1927, at Price County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison

Fourth--Honorable Fred H. Keller prosecuted the case.
