Application of Clay E. Snyder (4803)

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of burglary, third degree.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 6th day of January A. D. 1927, at Price, County of Carbon and State of Utah, in Fourth District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from six months to three years and thereafter was imprisoned in the state prison at Salt Lake City, Utah.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred M. Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Clay A. Snyder I was convicted under the name of ditto

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none other

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the foregoing.
