Application of Clay E. Snyder No. 5743.

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a termination ~~or parole~~ and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of "Grand-larceny."

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the ninth day of December A. D. 1931, at Duchesne County of Duchesne, and State of Utah, in The Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George W. Worthen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to from one to ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable M.B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Clay E. Snyder. I was convicted under the name of Clay E. Snyder.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: H.L. Snyder.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show.
