I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination to leave state  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of May 1929  
A. D. 1929, at Monte Utah County of San Pete  
and State of Utah, in Seventh District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Hilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Twenty five to forty years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John Patrick Ryan  
I was convicted under the name of John Ryan

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are  
as follows: Frank Anderson and Fred Buer

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except once in Montana  
any other Record of me is a forged Record
