I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination to Leave state
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah state Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of First Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27 day of May
A. D. 1929, at Montic County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in The Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Twenty Nine to forty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah state Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John P. Ryan

I was convicted under the name of John P. Ryan

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Fred Bower Frank anderson

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except once Montana my
other Record of me is a forged Record.
It is an elementary as well as a fundamental Principle of
our jurisprudence that Persons accused of a crime can only be
convicted upon legal Evidence and not upon the mere beliefs of
Persons who may be called as Witnesses. This covers my case
