First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 1st Deg.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of San Pete
and State of Utah, in The Seventh District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Dilworth Woolley presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Twenty Five To Forty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Fred Keller prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is John P. Ryan
I was convicted under the name of John Ryan
