Application of George Meason #4908

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 30th day of September, A. D. 1927, at Provo, County of Utah and State of Utah, in the Fourth Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George P. Parker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is George Meason I was convicted under the name of George Meason

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Delbert Peterson.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
