First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Attempted Rape

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of September A. D. 1927, at Provo County of Utah and State of Utah, in 4th District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Geo. P. Parker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Indeterminate and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable M. B. Pope prosecuted the case.
