Application of Auer Peterson

and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 3rd Degree

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of November
A. D. 1927, at Richfield County of Piute
and State of Utah, in the Sixth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Nephi J. Bates presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable Henry E. Beal prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Auer Peterson
I was convicted under the name of Auer Peterson
