Application of Allan Reid

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a commutation of sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County Jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 7th day of 14 A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable N. H. Tanner presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve six months

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County Jail

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph S. Nelson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Allan Reid

I was convicted under the name of Allan Reid

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Lew Jeremy, Dean Ellis and Arthur Phillips.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except petit larceny, 1923
