Application of Ernest Sam Mitchell No. 1115

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Discharge and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of August A. D. 1922, at Salt Lake County of Utah and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James W. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to serve and execute inmate term of five to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison as an intermittent term of five to twenty years

Fourth-Honorable Joseph Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Sam Mitchell

I was convicted under the name of Ernest Sam Mitchell

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
