Application of Melrose Lister

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of May A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wright presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State prison

Fourth-- Honorable Mr. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Melrose Lister I was convicted under the name of same

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except that which record shows.
