First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of May,  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term,  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable F. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Melrose Lister  
I was convicted under the name of same

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
