Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of May, A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Melrose Litster I was convicted under the name of same.
