Application of William Stone Jr.

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Pardon
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Penitentiary (parole)
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of felony (destroying R.R. property)

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 19 day of August
A. D. 1929, at Logan County of Cache
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Melvin Harris presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to the Utah State Penitentiary for a
term not to exceed ten years.
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison until
the eleventh of October 1929 when I was released on parole
under which condition I am still serving.

Fourth-Honorable Wesley Horsley prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is William Stone

I was convicted under the name of William Stone Jr.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none
