Application of P. Serdo No. 5117

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary Third Degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of January, A. D. 1929, at Ogden, Utah County of Weber, and State of Utah, in the Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker, presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is P. Serda, I was convicted under the name of Same.
