Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of May A. D. 1927, at Ogden City County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. Kimball presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-- Honorable J. E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Barney Griffin I was convicted under the name of Barney Griffin

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Frank Clark.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except nil.
