Application of Lee Lim

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of second degree murder.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 14th day of October A. D. 1926, at Bingham County of Salt Lake State of Utah, in third district Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Chris Mathewson presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from ten years to life and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable E. O. Rodgers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Harry Kyoo Lim I was convicted under the name of Lee Lim

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: S. Y. Yang

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except none other.
