Application of Walter R. Demes No. 5216

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Grand larceny

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 10th day of June,
A. D. 1929, at Duchesne County of Duchesne
and State of Utah, in the Fourth District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Larsen presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one year to ten
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Pope prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Walter Raymond Demes
I was convicted under the name of Walter R. Demes

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are
as follows: Burton Dawson, Dick Campbell

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as record shows
in the name of Walter R. Nicodemus
