Application of Neal Johnson #4928

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 22nd day of November,  
A. D. 1927, at Price, Utah. County of Carbon  
and State of Utah, in the Seventh Judicial District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George Christensen presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to indeterminate term,

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-- Honorable Fred W. Keller prosecuted the case.
