I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison, under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Burglary 2nd Degree.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 18th day of May, A. D. 1929, at Farmington, Utah County of Davis and State of Utah, in the First Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable E. B. Pratt presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.
