Application of Robert Taintor #4734

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a <sup>Rehearing of</sup> Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Depriving the Owner of Vehicle.
