I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination to Parker, Ariz. and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglary

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 28th day of September A. D. 1926, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison
