and State of Utah, in Tarmington Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to One to Ten Years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison at Salt Lake-
City

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Robert Young
I was convicted under the name of Robert Young

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except Grand Larceny
