Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 6 day of September

and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to An indeterminate term of one to twenty  
years.  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable David J. Wilson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Theodore Rogers.

I was convicted under the name of Theodore Rogers

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except none.
