Application of Victor Bronislaus Stanislaus Libertowski No. 5271

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of third degree Burglary.

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 26th day of October  
A. D. 1929, at St. George County of Washington  
and State of Utah, in the fifth District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable LeRoy Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate sentence of from six  
months to three years  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Karl N. Snow prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Victor Bronislaus Stanislaus Libertowski  
I was convicted under the name of Victor Bronislaus Stanislaus Libertowski.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except as records show.
