Application of Elmo Boyack #4861

On the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment on Parole under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 5th, day of May, A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable L. B. Wight presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison,

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Elmo Boyack
I was convicted under the name of same.

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: H. Bland.

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
