Application of SANFORD TRUMAN FERRY

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parol to my father, W. Mont Ferry, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of involuntary manslaughter

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the third day of October A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Morris L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Six months in the Salt Lake County jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the Salt Lake County jail

Fourth-- Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Sanford Truman Ferry I was convicted under the name of Sanford Truman Ferry

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: NONE

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except NONE
