Application of Frank Thomas

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Salt Lake County jail under conviction and a sentence on a charge of petit larceny.

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the 23d day of August A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the City Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable O. C. Dalby presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to serve six months in the Salt Lake County jail and thereafter was imprisoned in the said jail and have been incarcerated since August 1st 1927.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph H. Nelson prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is Thomas John I was convicted under the name of Frank Thomas.
