Application of J. E. Donaldson # 726

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a ~~parole~~ or termination of sentence, and respectfully represent as follows:

First-- That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Carnal Knowledge

Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the day of November A. D. 1925, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable George S. Barker presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to Indeterminate not to exceed five years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison after appeal to State Supreme Court, said appeal not perfected.

Fourth-- Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-- My true name in full is John Edmund Donaldson I was convicted under the name of J. E. Donaldson

Sixth-- The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: none

Seventh-- I have never been convicted of any offense except misdemeanor once.
