and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Second Degree Burglery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 1st day of July
A. D. 1929, at Beaver City County of Beaver
and State of Utah, in Fifth Judicial District Court, in and for the
County and State aforesaid, Honorable Roy Cox presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth-Honorable Mr. Larsen prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is George D. Workman
I was convicted under the name of George D. Murphy.

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except As Record Shows.
