First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah Reformatory  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 12 day of December  
A. D. 1929, at Manti County of Sandwich  
and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable \_\_\_\_\_ presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to one to twenty years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the State pen for three months  
and have been on parole for two  
years and six months
