Application of James E. Holman #4980

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence (Conditional to South Dakota.) and respectfully represent as follows:

First--That I am serving a term of imprisonment in the Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Auto Theft.

Second--I was convicted and sentenced on the 21st day of February, A. D. 1928, at Salt Lake City, County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in the Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third--I was sentenced to an indeterminate term, and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison.

Fourth--Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth--My true name in full is Vernard C. Robinson I was convicted under the name of James E. Holman

Sixth--The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None.

Seventh--I have never been convicted of any offense except the above.
