Second-- I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of December A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of S.L. and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable M.L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-- I was sentenced to An indeterminate term of from five years to life. and thereafter was imprisoned in the State Prison


Fourth-- Honorable E.A. Rogers prosecuted the case.
