I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Pardon  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the Third day of December  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable M. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable A. A. Duncan prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chester R. Holmes  
I was convicted under the name of Chester R. Holmes
