I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of sentence  
and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison  
under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Robbery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 3rd, day of December  
A. D. 1927, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake  
and State of Utah, in Third District Court Court, in and for the  
County and State aforesaid, Honorable J. L. Ritchie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to Serve five years to life  
and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable E. A. Rogers prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Chester R. Holmes

I was convicted under the name of Chet Holmes
