Application of Eddie Collins No. 5207

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Pandering

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to 1-20-years

and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cott prosecuted the case.
