First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Pandering

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in The Third Judicial District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Oscar W. McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to an indeterminate term of from one to twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the The Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Codd prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Eddie Collins
