Application of Eddie B. Collins No. 5207

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Conditional Termination and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Branding

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 27th day of May A. D. 1929, at Salt Lake City County of Salt Lake and State of Utah, in Third District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge Oscar McConkie presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Ray Van Cotte prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Eddie B. Collins I was convicted under the name of Eddie Collins

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: Rex Lund, Mrs. Lund, Prop. of Walla Walla Hotel, Prop. of New Elk Hotel and Prop. of Weldon Hotel.

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except None
