Application of Sidney Arthur Lawrence No. 5000

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Parole and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23 day of March A. D. 1928, at Ogden County of Weber and State of Utah, in The second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable Judge James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One To Twenty years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Dist. Att. Evens prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sidney Arthur Lawrence I was convicted under the name of Sidney Dick Lawrence

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows: None

Seventh-I have never been convicted of any offense except at the State Industrial School
