Application of Sidney A. Lawrence No. 5000

To the Honorable Board of Pardons of the State of Utah:

I hereby apply to your Honorable Body for a Termination of Sentence and respectfully represent as follows:

First-That I am serving a term of imprisonment in The Utah State Prison under conviction and a sentence on a charge of Forgery

Second-I was convicted and sentenced on the 23rd. day of March A. D. 1928, at Ogden, County of Weber and State of Utah, in The Second District Court, in and for the County and State aforesaid, Honorable James N. Kimball presiding.

Third-I was sentenced to One to Twenty Years and thereafter was imprisoned in the Utah State Prison

Fourth-Honorable Joseph E. Evans prosecuted the case.

Fifth-My true name in full is Sidney A. Lawrence I was convicted under the name of Sidney D. Lawrence

Sixth-The names of persons charged to have been connected with the same offense are as follows:
